Trial limited to 350 runs for jump classes (500 runs per day).

**Move ups:**

Only available for regular classes on Saturday after the Regular classes Round 2.

**Day of Show Entries:**

DOS is taken starting on 7/1/2019. Day of show (DOS) entries are accepted (before the course is set), as well as add-on runs, if space permits, at the discretion of the secretary. No refunds will be given if that entry is pulled. All DOS are \$13.00/run.

**Refunds:**

Returned checks will be charged a \$25.00 processing fee. Full refunds prior to closing on July 1, 2019. Entries pulled after closing (including bitches in season, lame or injured dogs) will be charged a \$25.00 processing fee. There is NO online entry for this trial.

Rosette are available for those completing a Title Rosette and Commemorative Bar for each team completing a **NATCH**. **Please inform the Trial Chair of the possibility of completing your NATCH prior to running.** Ribbons and toys are collected on the honor system. All Ribbons, Rosettes, and Prizes must be picked up by end of day Sunday. None will be mailed. All unclaimed Ribbons, Rosettes, and Prizes remain the property of the awarding Club.

### JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

## Brief Summary of Rules:

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. <http://nadac.com/afirm/dogregfrm.asp> A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: [www.nadac.com](http://www.nadac.com)
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No collars, leads, food, toys, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course. No, food, toys, clickers within 10 feet of the ring. Food or small toys can be in a secure container in pocket during a containerized trial.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

## **AGREEMENT**

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), GOAL (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and Jefferson County Fairgrounds (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the afore mentioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons

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## **Run Pricing Info**

To encourage entry of all dogs in your household – young, old and everyone in between – we offer pricing by the run rather than by the package. All runs that you are paying for (all dogs from your household entered) are totaled to find the 'per run' price. This way that older dog that really enjoys and is still capable of a few tunnelers or weavers runs can enter at the same price as your 'package' dog. Or maybe you have a young dog not quite ready for weaves but could do other classes. Total that dog's runs into your household total and bring the 'per run' cost down. Let everyone in your house that can still safely enjoy the game do just that. This way you don't have to feel guilty about leaving them home!

To enter:

1. Use one entry form per dog.
2. Total the runs in each class in the right column. Add the column to get the total runs for that one dog for the weekend.
3. In the bottom part of the chart, total all the runs for each dog entered (use one page for the final calculation) that lives in your household. Find the 'per run' price range. Multiply the total runs for all dogs entered, by the price range. This is the total cost of entry.
